



## Minnesota Logger Education Program Application & Membership Requirements

Thank you for your interest in applying for membership with the Minnesota Logger Education Program (MLEP). Please follow the steps listed below, which are required to attain membership.

1. Complete and return the attached MLEP **Application Form** and application fee. You may make a copy of the completed form for your personal record.
2. The **Code of Ethics** for MLEP Logging Professionals is included in this packet. Sign and return it with the completed application. Retain a copy for your records.
3. Submit **Certification of Business Requirements** as outlined on the MLEP application form. If you have any questions or would like to receive assistance regarding certification of business requirements, please contact MLEP.
4. Applicants are required to attend **Two Days of Training**:
  1. [Online Forest Management Guideline Training](#) (eFMG) and
  2. [LogSafe Training](#) (CPR/1st Aid).

Your annual membership **renewal** will require attendance of two days of training each year:

1. [LogSafe Training](#), and
2. Six (6) hours of [MLEP training](#).

Operations that produce less than 1,000 cords per year may be eligible for discounted membership fees. To apply for the discounted membership complete and return the **CONSENT TO RELEASE INFORMATION**.

# MINNESOTA LOGGER EDUCATION PROGRAM

Applicants will be considered provisional members until the requirements listed below have been completed. Those applicants who satisfy provisional program requirements will achieve full membership status and will be entitled to program benefits. Those applicants who do not satisfy program requirements by December 31 after application date will be dismissed from the program.

Program members will be required, on an annual basis, to renew their membership and complete requirements necessary to maintain membership status. Program members who do not complete annual renewal requirements will allow their membership to lapse, must reapply to the program and will be subject to a reapplication fee.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

1. Attendance at classes as determined by the MLEP Board of Directors and the MN SFI-SIC.
2. Certification of all legal requirements listed below necessary to operate a logging business.
3. Verification of timber harvesting equipment ownership (Loggers only).
4. Signing the program *Code of Ethics* and returning it with the completed program application.
5. Payment of annual membership application fees.

## LOGGER MEMBERSHIP EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

The business owner is required to complete the following. If the business owner is not on the active logging site, there must be a Qualified Logging Professional (QLP) who has completed the following who is on the job site:

### First Year Training Requirements

**Guideline Training:** Up to 8 credit hours of training on Minnesota's Forest Management Guidelines and managing rare species (Online or in person)

**Safety Training:** Up 4 hours of first-aid and CPR training is required (LogSafe)

### Annual Training Requirements

**Continuing Education:** (6) hours of MLEP training every year through workshops on any accepted continuing education topic

**Safety Training:** Twelve (12) hours of safety training every two years to include:

- Eight (8) hours of CPR/First Aid training (4 hrs. CPR and 4 hrs. of First Aid)
- Four (4) hours of Safety Training (OSHA)

**Logging business owners and QLPs must complete a minimum of 6 hours of MLEP and LogSafe training each year.** Logging employees (in-woods) are required to attend at least four (4) hours of safety training each year and complete First Aid/CPR training every two years. *At a minimum, SFI requires that "Each crew must include a qualified logging professional who 1) Has completed the SFI training program; 2) Is the owner of, employee of or contractor for the wood produced; and 3) Has direct responsibility and is on-site regularly to carry out the roles and responsibilities of the qualified logging professional (e.g. safety, protection of soils, streams and other water-bodies).*

## CERTIFICATION OF LEGAL REQUIREMENTS:

The following legal requirements will be documented through the initial membership application process and verified each year during the membership renewal process or as determined by the Board of Directors. In submitting this application you certify that you:

1. comply with all Federal and State Tax Identification Numbers and applicable laws.
2. comply with all Workers Compensation Insurance requirements (if applicable).
3. comply with Unemployment Insurance requirements (if applicable).
4. have an active workplace accident and injury reduction ([AWAIR](#)) policy, that is available to employees (if applicable).
5. have an active substance abuse policy, that is available to employees (if applicable).
6. you participate in the drug and alcohol testing requirements or a program for truck drivers (if applicable).

## CONSENT TO RELEASE OF INFORMATION

The undersigned has applied to participate in the continuing education offerings of Minnesota Logger Education Program (“MLEP”) as a member. The application, of which this Consent to Release of Information is a component, represents that the undersigned qualifies as “small producer” who produces <1,000 cords per year. The small producer classification entitles the undersigned to a significant discount in annual fees to the programming offered by MLEP.

To enable MLEP to verify the applicant’s annual level of production, the undersigned by signature to this Consent to Release of Information authorizes MLEP to contact any purchaser of timber to determine the volume of timber delivered by the applicant at any time during the applicant’s membership in MLEP, and for the two years preceding such membership.

MLEP uses the information obtained solely to confirm qualification of the undersigned as entitled to the small producer discount and will release any information obtained only to the undersigned and to those officers, employees, and directors of MLEP charged with maintaining and enforcing MLEP policy with respect to membership.

The undersigned specifically releases and indemnifies MLEP and its officers, directors, employees and agents for any liability or claim which may result as a consequence of the collection or use of the information described in this Consent.
